THE READING RANGERS

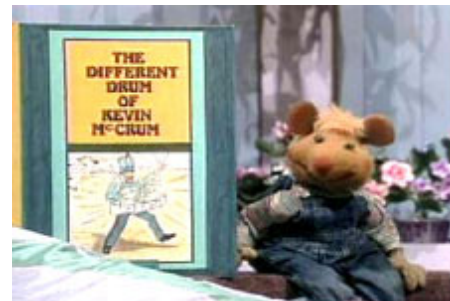

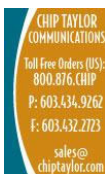
